














This information is being provided to assist you in hosting and preparing for Apostle Jonathan Pattersons' visit to your ministry. He is very low maintenance and easy to serve. When unsure, simply ask him. We thank you in advance for your care, thoughtfulness, and gracious hospitality.

FOODS and BEVERAGES: Apostle Patterson is developing healthy eating habits and prefers lite options such as vegetables and fruit snacks. He also tries to stick with chicken and fish dishes. After preaching, Apostle may wish to have dinner in his room. He appreciates 100% fruit juices and usually drinks water or Hot Tea while ministering. You may ask his preference before preparation is made.

AIRLINES: Apostles' first choice of air carrier is Delta Airlines; however, he is not opposed to flying Southwest or American Airlines. Please call our office before you arrange the final travel itinerary to make sure it fits within his schedule and to obtain his frequent flier number and birth date. He is fine flying coach class, however, he request that he has the option to select Business class seating and that he is not seated in the middle of other passengers. He does not always require first-class tickets but asks that you do not book him in a ticket class that restricts him from upgrading to first-class or changing the ticket. Apostles' schedule as a Pastor and national preacher is extensive; there may be some need for flexibility. Therefore, we request you purchase airline tickets to allow for change of itinerary. If a schedule change is a result of our need, we of course will assume the change fee. In addition, Apostle Patterson may require a companion ticket for one (1) adjutant depending on the location and type of service. Our office will advise.

HOTELS: Apostle prefers to stay in a non-smoking Queen bedroom in hotels that have Internet access in the room and indoor restaurants with late-night room service. Please advise us of your policy regarding room service, which he appreciates. Your assistance may be required to book accommodations for additional staff traveling with Apostle Patterson. Should he bring an adjutant, he will assume all financial responsibility for the room and meals.

GROUND TRANSPORTATION: Apostle may have CD/DVDs and books available for retail. It may be advisable to send male assistance to the airport to assist with these materials and his luggage. If staff is traveling with Apostle Patterson, they will need transportation from the airport to the hotel and to the church. They will be responsible for setting up the display. If he is traveling alone, please have someone available to assemble and disassemble the display and sell the product. An inventory sheet will be enclosed with prices and summaries.

AUDIO/VISUAL AID: Apostle requests to have a handheld cordless microphone with a stand while ministering if possible.

HONORARIUM: Apostle Pattersons' reputation precedes him, not only as a preacher with a revelatory Word for this end-time season, but also as a Father to Pastors and leaders. While he has **NO SET HONORARIUM**, he regularly receives a minimum of \$1500.00 each time he ministers. Any other responsibilities that you may desire or require of him should be compensated accordingly. Honorarium checks should be made payable to Jonathan Patterson.
